Write down the word that matches each definition and then find the words:

(Words can be spelt frontwards, backwards and positioned vertically, horizontally and diagonally)

- 1) Type of a golf course on the coast - (5) **Links**
- 2) Type of inland golf course. Often the holes are lined with trees and water - (8) **Parkland**
- 3) Closely mown grass areas that go from in front of the tee box up to the green- (7) **Fairway**
- 4) Area that you are trying to get the ball onto and where the hole is situated - (5) **Green**
- 5) A type of hazard that reminds you of a beach – (6) **Bunker**
- 6) Grass that is longer than the fairway and sometimes hard to get out of – (5) **Rough**
- 7) Turf that is removed from the ground when a players swing hits the grass – (5) **Divot**
- 8) A ball that curves from left to right and finishes on the target (for a right-handed player) – (4) **Fade**
- 9) A ball that curves from right to left and finishes on the target (for a right-handed player) - (4) **Draw**
- 10) A warning shouted to alert other players that a ball in flight is heading in their direction – (4) **Fore**
- 11) A mark made on the green when a ball lands – (9) **Pitchmark**
- 12) The position of your feet when addressing the ball – (6) **Stance**
- 13) The name given to a format where you keep hitting shots until you get your ball in the hole – (10) **Strokeplay**
- 14) One shot over par – (5) **Bogey**
- 15) A number given to an individual to indicate their skill and scoring ability – (8) **Handicap**
- 16) One shot under par – (6) **Birdie**
- 17) Two shots under par – (5) **Eagle**
- 18) Three shots under par – (9) **Albatross**
- 19) **Nett** score is your score once your handicap is taken off – (4)
- 20) You and your **marker** must both sign your scorecard at the end of the round – (6)
